It has been decided by the Government of India to implement 27% OBC reservation (Non-Creamy Layer) and 10% EWS reservation in 15% Under Graduate (UG) All India Quota seats (MBBS/BDS) (contributed by the State/UTs to the Central Pool). This reservation will take effect from the current Academic session 2021-22.

Consequently, the overall reservation for admission to Under Graduate (UG) Medical Courses (MBBS/BDS) under 15% All India Quota seats, would be as follows:

- S.C.- 15%
- S.T.- 7.5%
- O.B.C.- (Non-Creamy Layer) as per the Central OBC List- 27%
- EWS- As per Central Government norms- 10%
- PwD- 5% Horizontal Reservation as per NMC norms
